

GODDESS BRACELET - by Sara Lovecraft



Bring out your inner goddess with this unique style of beaded jewelry.

SUPPLIES:

- Beadalon 19 Strand Bead Stringing Wire, Silver, .015"
- Beadalon Findings Variety Pack
- Beadalon Crimp Covers Variety Pack
- Matte Opal Glass Round Beads, 6mm by Bead Landing
- Beadalon Wire Guardians
- Beadalon Crimp Tubes Variety Pack
- (2) Beadalon 6mm Jump Ring

TOOLS:

- Tying Station
- Sparkle Chain Nose Pliers
- Sparkle Bent Chain Nose Pliers
- Sparkle Round Nose Pliers
- Sparkle Cutter Tool
- Crimper Tool

1. Cut 24 inches of bead stringing wire.
2. Thread a wire guardian onto the wire and bring it to the middle of the wire.
3. Thread a crimp tube onto the wire and crimp with the crimper tool.
4. Cover the crimp tube with a crimp cover.
5. Use a large jump ring to attach the wire guardian to the Tying Station.
6. Thread a bead onto one of the wires and slide it up to the crimp cover.
7. Thread 2 6mm jump rings onto both bead stringing wires.
8. Thread a bead onto the opposite bead stringing wire.
9. Thread 2 jump rings onto both wires.
10. Repeat this process, thread a bead onto alternating wires with jump rings in between until you have reached the desired length.
11. Remove the bracelet from the Tying Station.
12. Thread a crimp tube onto both bead stringing wires.
13. Crimp.
14. Cut one of the bead stringing wires as close to the crimp as possible, leaving a single wire.
15. Add a crimp cover to the crimp tube.
16. Thread a crimp tube onto the bead stringing wire and a wire guardian. Thread the wire back through the crimp and crimp with the crimper tool.
17. Cover the crimp with a crimp cover.
18. Using chain nose pliers, attach jump rings to either end of the bracelet and a clasp.
