



BLUE OPAL BEACH GLASS EARRINGS

Materials

Materials:

- German Style Round Wire, Silver 22 Gauge
- Silver Plated Ear Wires
- Silver Cable Chain
- Matte Aqua Opal Glass Beads, 6mm

Tools:

- Sparkle Chain Nose Pliers
- Sparkle Bent Chain Nose Pliers
- Sparkle Round Nose Plier
- Sparkle Semi Flush Cutter

Instructions:

STEP 1

Cut 3 one inch pieces of chain. Cut a six inch piece of 22 gauge wire.

STEP 2

Thread four beads, three pieces of chain and four more beads onto the wire and drop to the center of the wire.

STEP 3

Bend the wire to create a ring out of the beads. Bend one end of the wire straight up from the beads and wrap the other wire around the straight wire two to three times and trim the tail.

STEP 4

Using round nose pliers, create a wrapped loop with the wire and trim the tail.

STEP 5

Cut a 3 inch piece of 22 gauge wire. Create a wrapped loop on one end of the wire and thread a bead onto the wire. Create a wrapped loop on the opposite end of the wire but before making the wraps, thread the tail of the wire through the loop on the beaded ring. Create the wire wraps to secure the bead to the beaded ring and trim the tail.

STEP 6

Use pliers to attach an ear wire to the top loop of the bead.

STEP 7

Repeat these steps to create the second earring.
