

## EASY SEED BEAD TAPESTRY BRACELET by Sara Lovecraft



Learn how easy to make a geometric fashion statement with just a few supplies and techniques.

## **SUPPLIES:**

- Metal Chain, Silver
- Findings Variety Pack
- Eye Pins, silver
- Dazzel It 10/0 Metallic Czech Glass Seed Beads
- John Bead Czech Glass Seed Beads, 8/0 Gold
- John Bead 10/0 Czech Glass Seed Beads, Blue
- Mulitcolor Triangle Charms=

## TOOLS:

- Sparkle Chain Nose Pliers
- Sparkle Bent Chain Nose Pliers
- Sparkle Round Nose Pliers
- Sparkle Semi Flush Cutter

- 1. Map out the pattern you want to create with your beads before you begin. Your design should fit within seven rows down and fifteen beads across. We will be creating a triangle.
- 2. Thread seed beads, following the pattern, onto eye pins.
- 3. Using chain and round nose pliers, create simple loops on the ends of the eye pins.
- 4. Once you have filled seven eye pins with your beads, thread an 8/0 seed bead onto an eye pin, then thread one of the beaded eye pins onto the eye pin. Repeat this until you have added all the beaded eye pins with 8/0 seed beads between them.
- 5. End with an 8/0 seed bead and use pliers to create a simple loop on the end of the eye pin, securing all the beaded eye pins.
- 6. Repeat this process on the opposite end of the beaded eye pins.
- 7. Cut four half inch pieces of chain.
- 8. Using chain nose pliers, open each of the eye pins on the four corners of your design and thread on the end of one of the chain pieces. Close them back.
- 9. Cut two more four or five inch pieces of chain.
- 10. Using chain nose pliers, attach the two chain pieces on the sides of your design and a four or five inch chain piece with a jump ring.
- 11. Repeat on the other side of the bracelet.
- 12. Using chain nose pliers, attach jump rings to each end of the bracelet. Attach a triangle charm to one of the jump rings and a lobster clasp.
