

# JEWELRY MAKING 118: BADGE ID HOLDER

## STEP 1 - Make 2:

Cut a piece of Beadalon bead stringing wire 36 inches (91.5 cm) long. Thread one wire through a wire Guardian. Carefully pull the beading wire through the wire guardian so both ends are even. Thread one size 11 seed bead on each of the wires. Thread one superduo bead over both of the wires. Repeat until your strand is about 14 inches long. Use a crimp tube to attach the one half of the clasp.

## STEP 2

Add crimp covers over the crimp tubes.

## STEP 3

Attach the bottom wire guardians to the badge holder with jump rings.
