

MACRAME AND SLAY EARRINGS



Supplies:

- 6 feet of RePEaT Jewelry Cord or Leather Cord 1.0mm (Beadalon or Leathercord USA)
- (2) Large Round Quick Link or Circle Connectors (Beadalon or Tierracast)
- (2) C-Crimp Findings or Crimp End Caps with a Loop (Beadalon or Tierracast)
- (2) Earwires (Beadalon or Tierracast)
- (2) 6mm Crimp Covers (Beadalon)
- 4 or 6mm beads with >1mm holes (Dakota Stones, Jesse James Beads, Tierracast, Starman, Dreamtime Creations)

Tools (Beadalon):

- Chain Nose Pliers
- Round Nose Pliers
- Cutter
- WildFire Cord Cutter
- Scissors

Instructions:

STEP 1

Cut a 3 foot length of RePEaT Jewelry Cord.

STEP 2

Fold the cord about two inches from the end, and attach to the link with a lark's head knot.

STEP 3

Use the long end of the cord to tie a half hitch knot from BACK to FRONT over the link.

STEP 4

Use the long end of the cord to tie a half hitch knot from FRONT to BACK over the link.

STEP 5 (optional)

Add a bead on the long end of the cord and snug it up against the ring.

STEP 6

Repeat steps 3-5 until you've reached back around to the other side.

STEP 7

Bring the two cord ends together, and slide a crimp cover around the two strands of cord to keep them together. Close the crimp cover around the cords using the chain nose pliers. Use the WildFire Cord Cutter to trim the two ends to about 1/4" long.

STEP 8

Cover the ends with the C Crimp or Crimp End Cap and use the chain nose pliers to squeeze it shut.

STEP 9

Use a jump ring to attach the top of the C Crimp to an ear wire.

Repeat to make a second earring.
